R. R. Tolkien for use in his fantasy stories set in Arda, primarily in Middle-earth. Sindarin is one of the many languages spoken by the immortal Elves, called the Eledhrim [ˈelɛðrɪm] or Edhellim [ˈedhɛlɪm] in Sindarin. A very short primer and introduction to writing English words in Elvish. Elvish languages are constructed (made up) languages used by Elves in a fantasy setting. Tolkien conceived a family tree of Elvish languages, all descending from a common ancestor called Primitive Quendian. He worked extensively on how the languages diverged from Primitive Quendian over time, in phonology and grammar, in imitation of the development of real language families.
